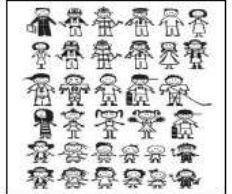


Reception Topic Plan

Communication, Language and Literacy

We will be ...

- Blending sounds together to hear words using our robot 'Metal Mickey' e.g d-o-g makes dog
- Taking home an Oxford Reading Tree book and learning the words: Biff Chip, Kipper, Floppy, Mum, Dad, the, and.
- Listening to stories about families and talking about our own.
- Drawing pictures of houses, ourselves and families.
- Holding a pencil correctly and forming letters.

Physical Development

We will be ...

- Finding and naming parts of our bodies.
- Using our hands to control tools and equipment such as pencils and scissors.
- Going to the toilet by ourselves and taking care of our own personal hygiene.
- Eating a range of healthy food as part of our school dinner.
- Negotiating space successfully when playing racing and chasing games. Adjusting our speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles.

Mathematics

We will be ...

- Saying number names in order to 10.
- Learning number songs.
- Weighing objects and using the language of heavier and lighter.
- Recognising numbers 1 to 10.
- Recognising numicon pieces up to 10.
- Counting up to 6 objects accurately.
- Selecting the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5.
- Realising that not only objects but anything can be counted including steps, claps or jumps.

Understanding the world

We will be ...

- Talking about ourselves and members of our family.
- Describing features of houses.
- Talking about family customs and routines.
- Using simple programs on the computer.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be ...

- Exploring and enjoying new experiences in our classroom.
- Playing alongside other children and sharing toys and ideas.
- Discussing the Rainbow Rules that we follow in our classroom and around school.
