At KS1 our Disadvantaged children outperform those in the LA and nationally in all subjects. The gap between our non FSM children and FSM children is narrower than the gap between FM and Non FSM in the Local Authority and Nationally. In school the gap has diminished by -1 in reading and by -4 in Maths and stayed the same in writing.
