Suggestions - Involve parent's younger children in some of the classes, easier access for prams, crèche area for babies, longer courses to cover topics, offer classes out of school hours for working parents.

At Birkby Infant and Nursery School your child has the opportunity to join many extended school activities either at lunchtime or after school (until 4pm) e.g. Taekwondo, Multi skills, Bollywood and Street Dance, Cooking, Tennis, Football, Art and Culture, Stretch and Flex, Gymnastics and Gardening. We also have a Breakfast Club each morning from 8am offering a healthy start to the day (£3 a week) and an After School Care Club (£1 per day) to support working parents/those in education (Monday to Thursday 3.15 to 5pm, Friday 3.15 to 4pm).
