Phonics Screening Check

Cancellation of the phonics screening check in June 2021 means pupils starting year 2 in September 2021 will not have taken the check in year 1. In the 2021/22 academic year, the DfE have confirmed that it is statutory for schools to administer a past version of the phonics screening check to year 2 pupils during the second half of the 2021 autumn term.

The autumn check is intended to ensure that year 2 pupils who need support in learning to decode using phonics are not missed.

Year 2 pupils who meet the expected standard in phonics in the 2021 autumn check will not be required to complete any further statutory assessments in phonics. Year 2 pupils who do not meet the expected standard in the 2021 autumn check will be expected to take the statutory check in June 2022, alongside year 1 pupils.

In order to prepare children for this, Year 2 children are taking part in daily phonics sessions to recap sounds that should have been taught in Year 1. To help your child with this, please <u>try to read with your child daily to practise applying their phonics.</u>
