This details the impact that our pupil premium activity had on pupils in the 2024 to 2025 academic year.

2024 end of KS1 Outcomes for disadvantaged children in Reading were good

- 66.7% achieved Expected or above -Compared to Nationally it was 58.5%.

2024 end of KS1 Outcomes for disadvantaged children in Writing were broadly in line with National

- 46.2% achieved Expected or above-compared to Nationally 48.7%

2024 end of KS1 Outcomes for disadvantaged children in Maths were good

- 59.0% achieved Expected or above-compared to Nationally 58.9%

Phonics-Y1

- 75.6% of disadvantaged children achieved the pass mark compared to Nationally 68.4%

2024 – GLD scores for Disadvantaged children were above the National.

Birkby I&N – 69.7%, National – 61.5%
