Provision and strategies already in place:

- Access to translators.

- Mid-Year Induction policy and programme.  
Specific Programmes for new to English children in Maths and Reading including phonics.
- Further development of use of Makaton – teacher communication fans with key survival vocabulary.
- Parents' evenings in the autumn and spring terms and school reports in the summer term.
- Availability of staff who speak Punjabi, Urdu, Polish, Hindi, Mirpuri, Spanish and Hungarian.
- Use of texting service to inform parents/carers of snow days etc
- Stay and Play sessions in EYFS.
- Use of Tapestry in EYFS to share children's achievements at school with parents and achievements at home with teachers.
- Sign posting to 'Basic English' classes for parents/carers.
- Termly time table of planned events for all year groups.
- What we are learning in school this week for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children.
- Parents support group for parents of children with SEN/D.
- Specified paper for dyslexic staff to print out own letters.
